

## **Sample Lesson Plan – Creek Students**

### **9:30-9:35 // Intro Activity**

- Use the first five minutes of class time for the intro activity. If there is no activity, spend some time catching up with your students about how the previous week went.

### **9:35-9:45 // Tell the Story**

- Teach the scripture for the week in story form. You can use the “background info for leaders” section of the lesson as a tool for this. Feel free to use some of the family ministry’s recommended resources for this part of the lesson as well.

### **9:45-10:00// Rebuild the Story**

- Once you’ve told the story, have the students retell it. Then, use the “storying questions” to help the students see the key aspects of the lesson.

### **10:00-10:10 // Gospel Emphasis & Attributes of God**

- Scripture will always point us back to God and the message of the Gospel. Take this time to remember this week’s passage is not just an isolated story, but all Scripture points to the greater narrative that God sent His Son, Jesus, to right our wrongs and intends to dwell with us forever again. If we walk away from the Bible with only facts and details, but miss encountering God Himself, we’ve missed the heart of it.

### **10:10-10:15 // Prayer**

- Use the “prayer prompt” as a model for how to pray over the truths from the day’s lesson. And take a few minutes to ask around for prayer requests. Have a student pray.
