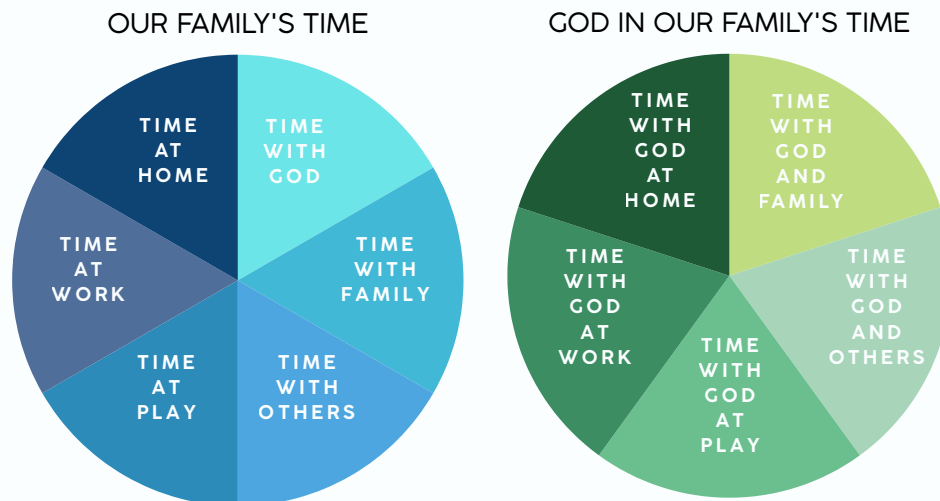


WHAT IS FAMILY DISCIPLESHIP?

- Parents actively passing on the faith. (Matt. 22:37-40; 28:19-20)
- Parents guiding unending conversations about the Gospel. (Deut. 6:7)
- Parents preparing their children for the path God has promised. (Deut. 1:35-36)
- Parents modeling the recognition of God's movement through time, moments, and milestones. (Eph. 5:15-16)
- Parents leading the family in response to God's Word, love, and heart. (Deut. 5:22-33)
- Parents creating habits in response to God's grace. (Deut. 6)
