God's Weariness

- "You have wearied the LORD with your words." (Mal. 2:17)
- Complaints of Judah:
 - 1. Everyone who does evil is good.
 - 2. The LORD delights in them.
 - 3. Where is the God of justice?

The People's False Complaints (2:17)

- Prosperity \neq God's favor.
- Proverbs 17:15 God condemns justifying the wicked.
- Psalm 73 perspective restored in God's presence.

Ouote:

"The problem was not with God's justice but with their perspective. The people pointed the finger at God when they should have been pointing it back at themselves." — **Micah Fries, Stephen Rummage, & Robby Gallaty**, Christ-Centered Exposition: Malachi

God's Answer: A Messenger (3:1)

- Promise: "I send my messenger... the Lord will come to His temple."
- Fulfillment: John the Baptist
 - Matthew 3:3, Mark 1:2–3, Luke 3:4, John 1:23
 - Jesus confirms (Matt. 11:10)

Bridge to Today

- John prepared for Christ's first coming.
- We prepare for His second.

Who Was John the Baptist?

- Miracle birth (Luke 1:13–17)
- Set apart, Spirit-filled.
- Simple life, bold message: "Repent."
- Humility: "Not worthy to untie His sandal."

A Word for Us:

- Our call is to point people to Jesus.
- "Behold, the Lamb of God..." (John 1:29)

The Lord Comes to His Temple

- Jesus enters the temple:
 - As a baby (Luke 2:27)
 - As a teacher (Luke 19:47)
 - As judge (Matt. 21:12–13)

Truth: Judgment begins in the house of God.

• Cleansing starts with His people.

♦ The Refiner's Fire (3:2-4)

- Like a refiner's fire
- Like fuller's soap
- Goal: purity, reflection of Christ.

Supporting Scriptures:

- 1 Peter 4:17
- Hebrews 12:6
- 1 Cor. 3:13

Quote: "God's refining work is often painful, but it is never without purpose. He disciplines us not to destroy us, but to conform us into the image of His Son." — **R.C. Sproul**, Essential Truths of the Christian Faith

God Draws Near for Judgment (3:5)

- Calls out sins:
 - Sorcery (Deut. 18:10–12; Acts 8:9).
 - Adultery (Ex. 20:14; Heb. 13:4).
 - Lying (Lev. 19:12; Col. 3:9).
 - Oppression of workers (Lev. 19:13; Jas. 5:4).
 - Neglect of widows, orphans, foreigners (Ex. 22:21-22; Jas. 1:27).

Truth: These sins are alive today.

- The proud judged.
- The repentant shown mercy.

The Only Reason We Are Not Consumed (3:6)

- "For I the LORD do not change; therefore you... are not consumed."
- Justice & mercy meet at the **cross**.

Quote: "If God were changeable, Israel would have been destroyed long ago. Our hope is anchored in His immutability. The God who made covenant promises will never break them." — **A.W. Pink**, The Attributes of God
